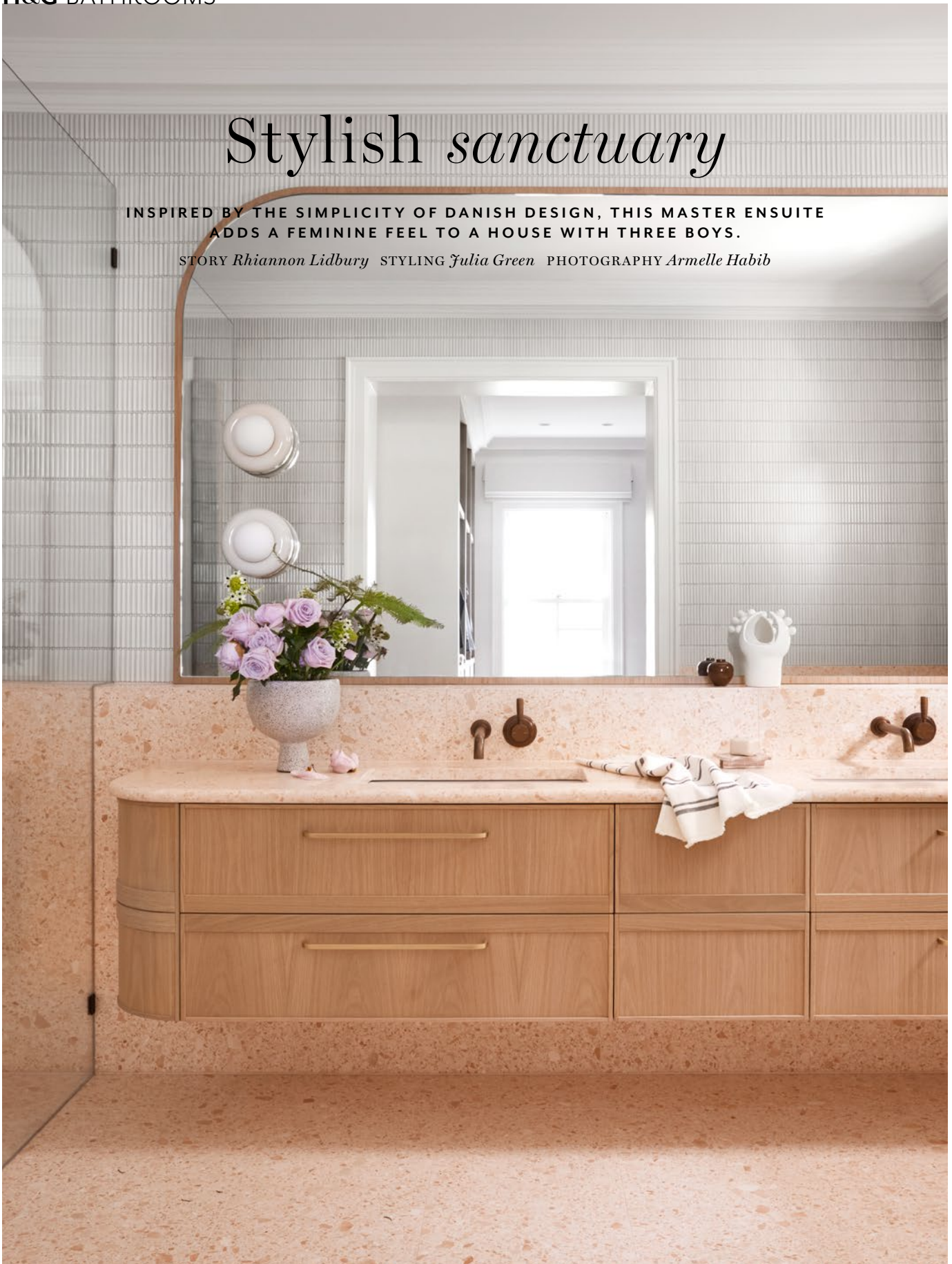


Stylish sanctuary

Wanting to give the homeowners this practical yet peaceful space, the team at Kate Walker Design opened up the floorplan with a complete redesign. With a love for functional, comfortable Danish design, the owners wanted an “easy to care for” space offering a feminine touch in a house with three boys. “Our client was our inspiration,” says Kate Walker. “We have worked with them before on a previous project and really understood the feeling they wanted, and how important Danish design was to the aesthetic.” Pavlova terrazzo tiles guide the space in a muted peach, while the gentle curves of soft timber within the vanity augment the blush terrazzo, creating a harmonious space that is calming for the owner. “She absolutely loves it,” says Kate. “When she closes the door, it’s her own space with a beautiful feminine essence that is fresh and cocooning.” ▶
